

For Windows

■ Installation and updating

If the application has already been installed, following these installation procedures will update it by reinstalling it.

Disconnect the product from the computer before installation/uninstallation.


Close all other running applications before launching this application.

1. Download the Windows file.
Download the ZIP file that contains the installer from the M3 download page.




2. Extracting the ZIP file.

Select the folder where you downloaded the ZIP file. ① Click "Compressed Folder Tools", then ② "Extract All". The ZIP file will be extracted.




3. Double-click the installer file.

4. Click "Next >".




5. Click "Next >".




6. Click "Next >".


When "Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?" appears in a pop-up, select "Yes".



7. This starts installation.




8. Click "Close" to complete installation.




■ Confirming installation

Follow the procedures below to check whether or not the application has been installed.


1. Open the **Start** menu.




2. Open the “ZOOM” folder, and click this application.



3. When a pop-up appears, select “OK”.



4. Open “About” in the Help menu.



5. Check the version.
Confirm that it is the latest version.





Try the following if you cannot find the application.


- Check the name of the installed application.

■ Uninstallation


1. From the **Start** menu, open **Settings**.



2. Select **Apps**.



3. Select the product driver from **Apps & features**.





4. Select **Uninstall** to execute uninstallation.

For Mac

■ Installation and updating

Download the ZIP file that contains the installer from the M3 download page.




2. Open the file.

After downloading, click ① "Downloads", which appears at the bottom of the screen by default. Then, click

②. This will open the dmg file.




3. Drag the M3 Edit & Play file and drop it into the Applications folder.



■ Confirming installation

Follow the procedures below to check whether or not the application has been installed.

1. From the Applications folder, open the “M3 Edit & Play”.
2. When a pop-up appears, select “OK”.



3. Click “About ZOOM M3 Edit & Play” in the menu.




4. Check the version.
Confirm that it is the latest version.



■ Uninstallation

1. Open the Application folder.



2. Drag the "M3 Edit & Play" to the trash or select it and choose File > Move to Trash.
