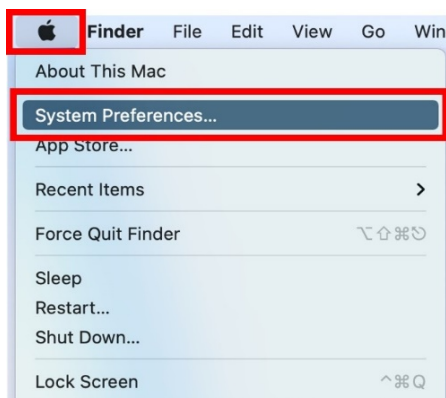
How to set up for HDMI output on Mac

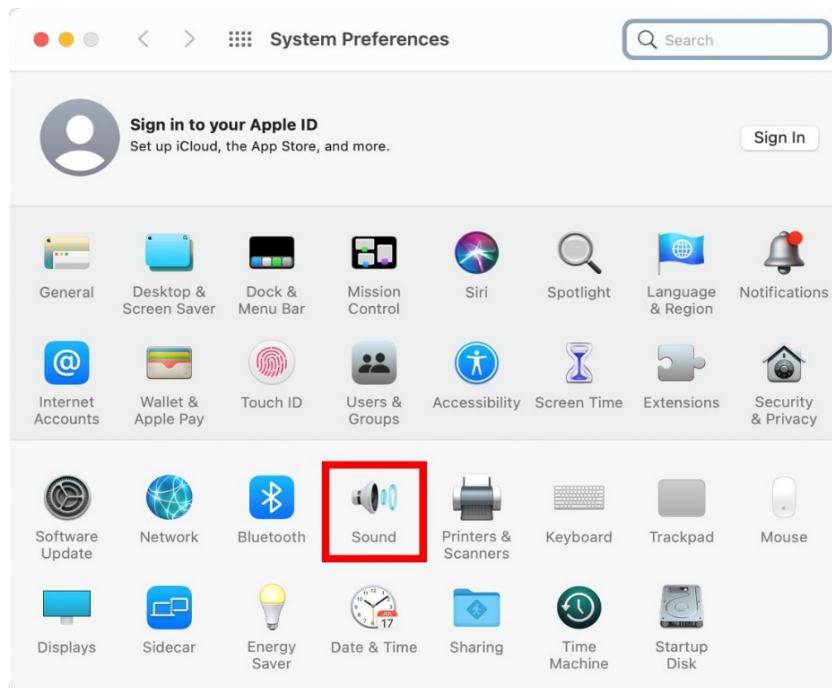
ZOOM Ambisonics Player sometimes cannot play files when Mac is connected to a sound output device such as an external AV amplifier via HDMI.

The following steps enable ZOOM Ambisonics Player to playback files.

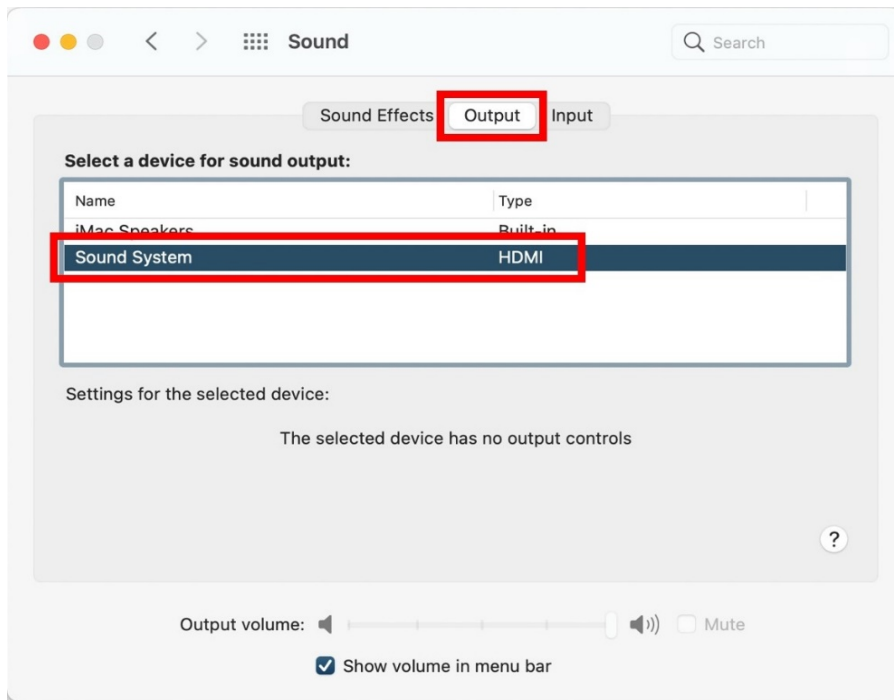
1. Quit ZOOM Ambisonics Player.
2. Click [Apple menu] > [System preference...].



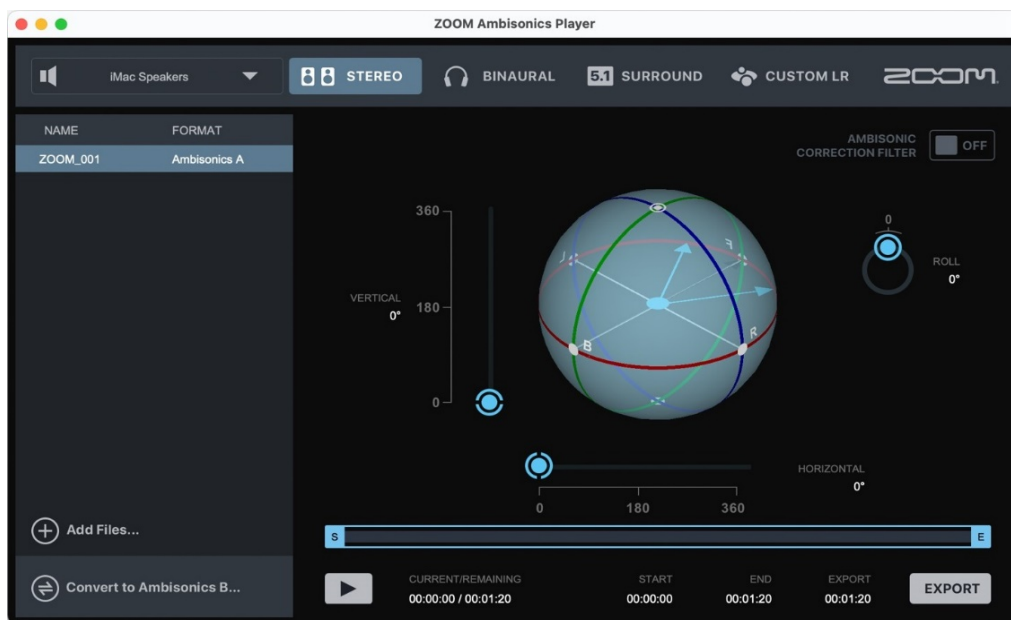
3. Click [Sound].



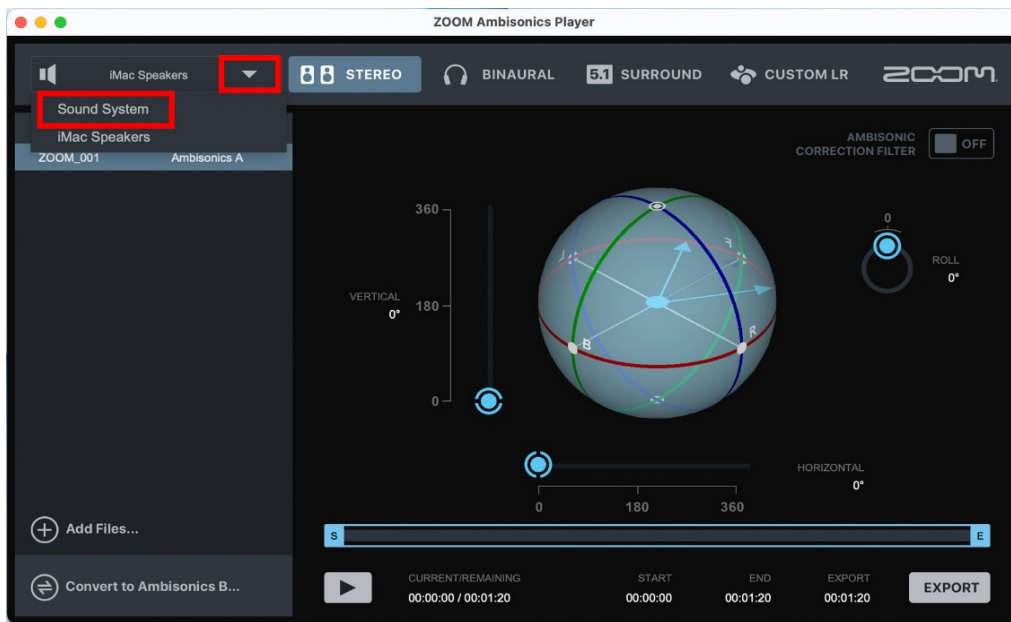
4. Select the device that outputs the playback sound of ZOOM Ambisonics Player.



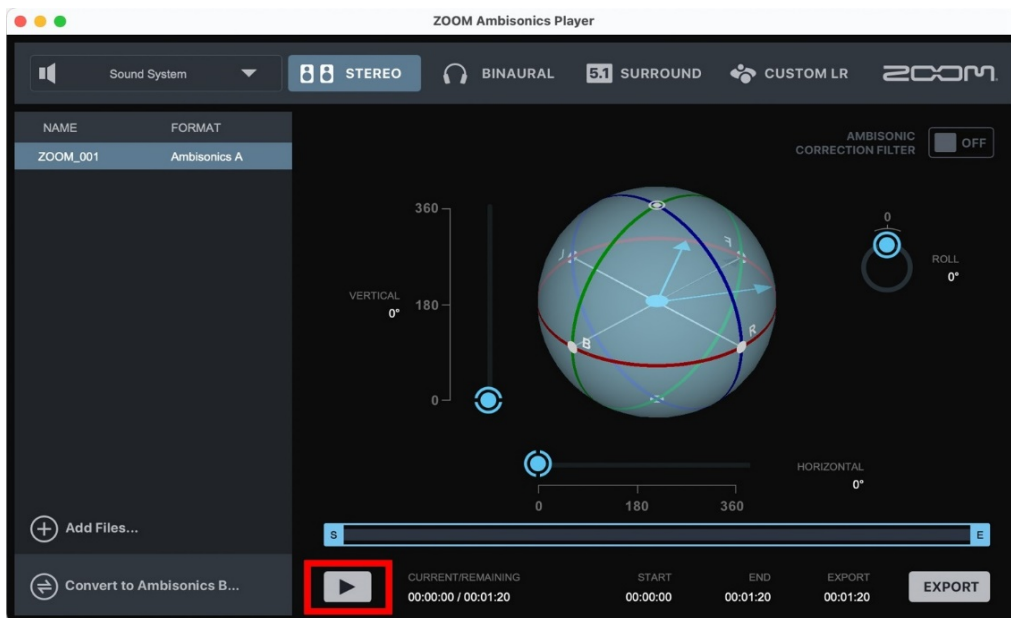
5. Start ZOOM Ambisonics Player.



6. Select the output device in step 4 on ZOOM Ambisonics Player.



7. Confirm ZOOM Ambisonics Player can playback files.
